The band has evolved through several name changes; until the present day 'Loxley Silver Band' and has managed to maintain playing since 1889 without a break through two world wars.

Based in North Sheffield, the band has a friendly family atmosphere with players ranging from 10-80 years! The Band play various local events such as garden parties, concerts, galas etc. throughout the year and play Christmas tunes and 'local carols' at a variety of venues during December.

Loxley Silver Band rehearses on Monday and Thursday evenings from 7:45pm to 9:30pm at Stanwood Methodist Church, Stanwood Drive, Sheffield S6 5HZ.

They recently won first prize in their section at the 2013 Bolsover Festival of Brass.
